## GUIDELINES FOR UWF BEREAVEMENT FUNCTIONS

The United Women in Faith (UWF) will be available to host a bereavement gathering or lunch for the family of a deceased member of Long Memorial on the day of the funeral or memorial service. The Bereavement Committee chair or designee will contact the family to ascertain the date and time of the service, and to arrange the time of the gathering or lunch and the approximate number to be served. The Bereavement Committee chair or designee will then inform each Circle chair of the time and date of the gathering or lunch and the approximate number to be served.

The following will be served for gatherings:

- Circle #1     Fruit skewers
- Circle #2-3   Sausage balls or chicken salad tarts
- Circle #4     Sweets
- Circle #5     Pimento cheese sandwiches

The Bereavement Committee chair or designee will order ham biscuits.

If the family prefers a lunch, the menu will be determined by the Bereavement Committee according to the season and number to be served. Each Circle will then be given an assignment.

For both gatherings and lunches, the Bereavement Committee chair or designee will request volunteers from each Circle to help with set-up, beverages, flowers, serving, and clean-up.

## SPAGHETTI CASSEROLE

2 lbs. ground beef  
2/3 cup onion – chopped  
1/2 cup green bell pepper – chopped  
2 ½ tsp. dried oregano  
2 ½ tsp. garlic powder  
56-59 oz. Ragu Traditional Sauce (4 14-oz. jars OR one 14-oz. and one 45-oz. jar)  
1 lb. spaghetti noodles (not thin or angel hair)  
3/4 cup water  
1 6-oz. package shredded Parmesan cheese (not the dry shaker kind)

Brown ground beef with onion, bell pepper, oregano, and garlic powder.

Drain grease from meat. Pour the Ragu sauce into the meat mixture.

Use the water to rinse the sauce out of the jars and add this to the sauce mixture.

Heat until bubbly. Meanwhile, boil noodles until done.

Drain the noodles and combine with the meat sauce in a **deep 9"x13" disposable aluminum pan** sprayed with a light coating of Pam.

Sprinkle the shredded Parmesan cheese over the top. Cover with foil.

Bake the assembled casserole uncovered for 30 minutes at 350°. Serves 15.

## SLOW COOKER BARBEQUE PORK

1 10-lb. pork butt  
1/2 cup apple vinegar  
1/2 cup Grandma's molasses  
1 bottle George's barbeque sauce

Spray large slow cooker with Pam and put the pork butt in. Mix together vinegar and molasses and pour over the butt. Cook 8 hours (10 hours if pork butt is frozen) on low. Baste about once an hour during the last four hours. Remove butt, cool enough to handle, and then remove the bone and fat. Shred meat and place it in a deep 9"x13" disposable aluminum pan. Pour 1/2 - 3/4 bottle of barbeque sauce over shredded meat. Cover with foil and marinate in refrigerator overnight. Reheat for 30 minutes at 350°. Serves 16-20.

*Tip: Food Lion has pork butts on sale for \$0.99/pound several times each year.*

## **PINEAPPLE CASSEROLE**

2/3 cup sugar

3/4 cup flour

2 20-oz. cans pineapple chunks, drained

1 20-oz. can crushed pineapple, drained

4 cups grated cheddar cheese

1 stack Ritz Crackers

1 stick butter, melted

Mix flour and sugar together. Mix pineapple and cheese. Add sugar and flour mixture to cheese pineapple mixture. Pour into greased 9" x 13" baking dish. Crush Ritz crackers, add melted butter and mix. Sprinkle over pineapple mixture and bake for 30 minutes at 350°.

## **SWEET AND SOUR GREEN BEANS**

8 slices bacon, cooked crisp and crumbled (reserve the drippings)

3 15-oz. cans French-style beans, drained

1 onion, sliced thin

6 Tbsp. vinegar

6 Tbsp. sugar

1/4 cup sliced almonds

Mix the vinegar and sugar in the bacon drippings. Layer the beans, onion, and bacon in a 9"x13" casserole dish. Pour the vinegar mixture over the beans, sprinkle with sliced almonds. (This may be assembled a day ahead to marinate and then baked the next day.) Bake for 30 minutes at 350°. Serves 9-12.

## **SAVORY GREEN BEANS**

4 15-oz. cans (*or the equivalent*) cut green beans

4 beef bouillon cubes

4 tsp. Mrs. Dash "Original Blend" seasoning

1/4 cup olive oil

Dissolve the bouillon cubes in some of the bean juice. Heat all together in a gallon size pot over medium heat, stirring occasionally, until it comes to a boil. Serves 12.

## **SAUSAGE AND CHEESE BALLS**

1 lb. bulk sausage, raw

1 C grated American or cheddar cheese

3 C Bisquick

Form into 1" balls and bake on a cookie sheet 15-20 minutes @350° until lightly brown.

## **GLENDAS CHILI**

3 lbs. ground beef  
1 large onion, diced  
1 large bell pepper, diced  
1 -- 2 Tbsp. chili powder  
1 tsp. crushed red pepper  
1 tsp. garlic salt  
2 tsp. black pepper  
dash of Tabasco sauce  
2 28-oz. cans crushed tomatoes  
1 15-oz. can tomato sauce  
1 6-oz. can tomato paste  
2 15-oz. cans pinto beans

Brown and crumble the ground meat in a large soup pot. Use a turkey baster to drain the grease off. Add the onion and bell pepper, and simmer until the onion is clear. Add seasoning ingredients and stir. Add canned ingredients with their juice. Rinse the cans with a little water, add it, and stir. Cover and simmer over low heat one to two hours, stirring occasionally. Serve with shredded cheddar or fiesta cheese sprinkled on top. Serves 12-15.

## **TACO SOUP**

1 lb. ground beef  
1 medium onion, diced  
1 pkg. (2 Tbsp.) Ranch dressing mix  
1 pkg. (1/4 cup) taco seasoning mix  
1 28-oz. can diced tomatoes  
1 4.5-oz. can chopped green chiles  
1 10-oz. can original Rotel tomatoes and chilies  
1 15-oz. can whole kernel corn  
1 15-oz. can kidney beans  
1 15-oz. can pinto beans  
1 28-oz. can water

Brown and crumble the ground meat in a large soup pot. Use a turkey baster to drain the grease off. Add the onion and simmer until the onion is clear. Add seasoning ingredients and stir. Add canned ingredients with their juice. Fill the diced-tomatoes can with water, rinse the other cans with it, add it to the soup, and stir. Cover and simmer over low heat 30 minutes, stirring occasionally. Serve with shredded cheddar or fiesta cheese sprinkled on top. Serves 12.
